I have the high honor of working with many people, from various backgrounds and the beauty of it all, is their stories. I love to hear and watch people light up as they share part of their life experience. Being a bit of a story teller myself I find it to be good medicine for us to share our lives in story form and I'm thankful for each one.






### Treasurer's Report
