

It is hard to believe that August is on our doorsteps and summer will be quickly coming to an end and the kids will be back in school.


With that said, I want to encourage everyone to pray. Pray for the schools! Pray for the teachers! Pray for all the staff! Pray for all of the students!

#### Treasurer's Report

Below is the financial report for June 2024. God continues to bless us with faithful givers. God is good, all the time!!

I want to let everyone know that the roofing project is completed using approximately \$11,000 from our savings. I want to remind everyone that as generously as you have supported this project, please remember your regular tithes and offerings to our general operations. We still have staff salaries, utilities and other expenses that are met through your regular giving. I am so grateful to our God for His provision to His people and your generosity with those provisions to the life and ministry here at First Christian.

HVAC UPDATE: Your generosity has raised approximately \$10,000, which was enough to make the initial order of the two units for the sanctuary. SO, it's time to dig in again and ask for your support for HVAC unit replacement. We anticipate the full cost to be around \$21,000 to replace two of the units that cool the sanctuary and one unit for the educational wing.

**E-GIVING UPDATE:** We are evaluating our online giving portal. There has been limited usage of the portal, and just recently we have been made aware of additional security testing that will be required to keep the product. I would like to hear from those of you that have used the online portal, primarily to let me know what impact the elimination of this portal would mean to your ability to contribute to the church. Alternatively, if there is anyone out there that would be willing to perform security testing for our system on a quarterly basis, please let me know.

As a reminder, please continue to check for LIGHTS, RUNNING TOILETS, A/C OR HEAT, etc. following all meetings at the church. Don't assume someone else will lock up or turn off. Also, if you become aware of maintenance issues with the property, please bring it to the attention of the Property Ministry Team or the church office. Thanks to Scott, Allen, George and all the rest of the guys who selflessly give their time to keep our facilities in great condition!!! Our Church is truly blessed!
