I send you greetings beloved in the name of Jesus Christ our Savior and Lord! Amen and AMEN! I'm writing you early this Thursday morning in part because I have my Pastor's Note due tomorrow and mostly because I woke up thinking about the disciples along with Peter hemmed up in a boat in an attempt to cross the lake to get to Gennesaret. So, before we get to the scripture let me set the scene.

Jesus feeds 5,000 plus women and children. You can find this in your bibles in Matthew 14:13-21; Mark 6:32-44; Luke 9:10-17; John 6:1-13. I give you those references because it's important to read all gospel accounts. It's like coloring with four different crayons. It brings into view a brighter and more vivid picture for us to see. So, Jesus has just taken five loaves of bread and two fish and fed the multitude. Why would He do that, you ask? Jesus has compassion for the people and because He understands their immediate need. They're hungry for goodness sake and if Jesus doesn't supply the remedy for their hunger pains; who will?

The funny thing is, people can get really off track and do so in wholesale fashion. Jesus knows that after healing their sick and filling their bellies, that they are looking to make him into a political King. Well of course Jesus saw the writing on the wall and sends his disciples on ahead as he heads up the mountainside to pray. Did Jesus go up the mountainside to be with His father or to get away from His new found fans? YES!

<sup>22</sup> Immediately Jesus made the disciples get into the boat and go on ahead of him to the other side, while he dismissed the crowd. <sup>23</sup> After he had dismissed them, he went up on a mountainside by himself to pray. Later that night, he was there alone, <sup>24</sup> and the boat was already a considerable distance from land, buffeted by the waves because the wind was against it. <sup>25</sup> Shortly before dawn Jesus went out to them, walking on the lake. <sup>26</sup> When the disciples saw him walking on the lake, they were terrified. "It's a ghost," they said, and cried out in fear. <sup>27</sup> But Jesus immediately said to them: "Take courage! It is I. Don't be afraid." <sup>28</sup> "Lord, if it's you," Peter replied, "tell me to come to you on the water." <sup>29</sup> "Come," he said. Then Peter got down out of the boat, walked on the water and came toward Jesus. . <sup>30</sup> But when he saw the wind, he was afraid and, beginning to sink, cried out, "Lord, save me!" <sup>31</sup> Immediately Jesus reached out his hand and caught him. "You of little faith," he said, "why did you doubt?"

### Turn your Eyes Upon Jesus

<sup>32</sup> And when they climbed into the boat, the wind died down. <sup>33</sup> Then those who were in the boat worshiped him, saying, "Truly you are the Son of God." <sup>34</sup> When they had crossed over, they landed at Gennesaret. <sup>35</sup> And when the men of that place recognized Jesus, they sent word to all the surrounding country. People brought all their sick to him <sup>36</sup> and begged him to let the sick just touch the edge of his cloak, and all who touched it were healed. **Matthew 14:22-36** 

Are you getting a sense of what it must be like to be held hostage by the wind and the waves? Could it be for us in this moment that the Coronavirus has the upper hand? Are you watching and listening and reading every media outlet to learn of how many new cases there are and what the total death tally is? Well it finally happened! Mercer County WV has confirmed that there is a person who had traveled out of the country, and has in fact contracted the Coronavirus and based on statistical data there will be more.

I think the Lord gave me this passage this morning for different reasons than you might think. I'm not going to encourage you to get out of the boat. In fact, I'm going to do the very opposite. I'm imploring you to stay in the boat! But understand this about the boat; the boat was tossed about in the middle of the storm! The boat should have likely capsized, but it didn't. God had His hand on the boat and no one even knew it and I think in part because when Jesus got in the boat, the wind ceased. They were overjoyed and rightfully so that the wind had ceased. The KJV says "ceased", meaning it came to an end. Church, this "STORM" will come to an end, and we all know there will be another one right behind it. Take courage! Don't be afraid! For "I AM" is with us! And so, let's not lose sight of the fact that God was with us yesterday, today and rest assured will be with us always!

So be careful to how much outside information you allow in. Yes, check your sources and be informed. But church, if we are not checking our God source, we are missing the boat. Did you notice verse 32? Go back and read it beloved. "THEY" climbed into the boat and the wind ceased. That's a powerful word church! That's the kind of stuff that will keep you getting up at 4am. Thank you Jesus!

Stay in the boat, but make absolute sure that you know, that you know, that Jesus is in the boat with you. Can I get an amen?
