"The rains would finally come and yes it was a sight for sore eyes, but it's not so much the rain I was thankful for. Looking back on it Howdy, I needed to experience that hot dry season. I know, I know that's not what you were wanting to hear. But son you have to understand to fully appreciate the life-giving sustenance of the rain you have to learn to appreciate the dry times."

You see it was my dad who told me about the dry times that he went through and how he learned to appreciate the lack of rain. He said it wasn't all bad.

## Howdy and Wisdom WHEN THE RAINS COME

Yes, it was hot and pretty miserable but he chose to take what came. "You see son, you can't control the uncontrollable," my dad told me.

"Now Howdy, do you remember the time you had the run in with the pretty black kitty with the white stripe on its back? You remember after you received good advice you chose to go on and do it your way? Left you pretty stinky didn't it? You see son that was a situation you had control over, but you chose poorly.

"We live in what they call four seasons country. We experience all kinds of weather patterns, from cold snowy days to days like today and everything in between. But the trick that I have learned is to take it as it comes. Son, I don't have control over what comes, I can only control how I receive it. Some days are cool and breezy with the occasional evening rain. Other days are like today and yes, it's hot and dry and at times pretty miserable. But how would we ever be able to appreciate the needed rain if it wasn't for the dry times?" - Howdy

Beloved, are you in a hot and dry time in your life? It may be a physically dry time for you or it may be a spiritually dry time that you are experiencing. But the truth is, you're still here. You've made it another day. You've experienced all the different weather patterns and our Father has seen fit to bring you through.

If I could leave you with some encouragement I would say, learn how to hold on. Don't become fixated on the things that are out of your control. Learn to appreciate the dry times so that you can better appreciate and enjoy the rain


